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## Update: OSHA delays electronic reporting requirement

Last year, we <u>alerted</u> clients of OSHA's new reporting requirements for certain employers to submit the information from their completed 2016 Form 300A electronically. As of Wednesday, OSHA has delayed this requirement, announcing it is not accepting electronic submissions of injury and illness logs at this time.

OSHA's intent is to propose extending the July 1, 2017 submission deadline; updates will be provided, when available, on their <u>website</u>.
